Subject: Standard Civil Money Penalty Amount Update

On June 21, 2019, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) released the final version of its revised Civil Money Penalty (CMP) calculation methodology that is used when the Medicare Parts C and D Oversight and Enforcement Group determines a CMP is the appropriate enforcement action to take against an organization to address identified deficiencies. The methodology outlined the approach for increasing minimum penalty amounts permitted under regulation at 42 C.F.R. §§ 422.760(b)(3) and 423.760(b)(3). CMS updated and announced the minimum penalty and aggravating factor amounts in 2022 and further stated the calculation and accrual of the standard minimum penalty and aggravating factor amounts would be tracked and announced on an annual basis. Therefore, CMS is announcing the updated 2025 accrued and applied CMP amounts via this HPMS Memo.
